- The engineering industry in Alberta is made up of 5,238 engineering establishments and 592 architectural companies.
- In 2006 the Albertan engineering industry had operating revenue of more than \$4 billion. Architecture had more than \$360 million.
- The cost of operating the engineering services industry, including salaries, wages and benefits, is nearly \$3.7 billion. The expenses for the architectural services industry run at \$300 million.

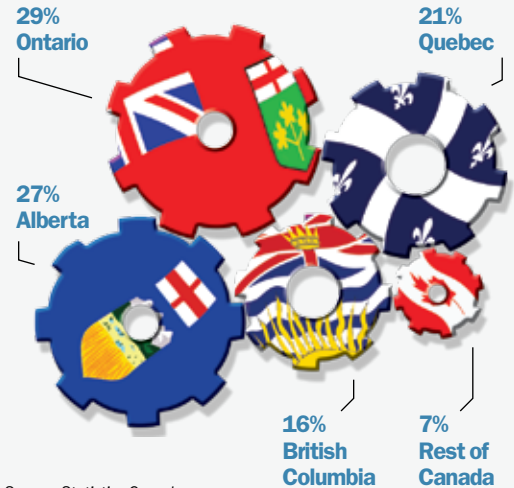

ENGINEERING SERVICES INDUSTRY REVENUES, BY PROVINCE, 2006



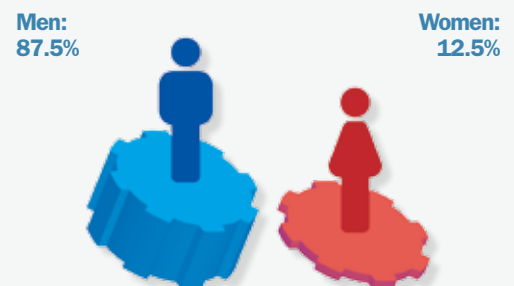
